Although only days old, the order is having a chilling effect on our members' efforts by discouraging international travel to study, work, collaborate and share ideas. ARVO is committed to diversity in all of our activities and to supporting all members, regardless of nationality or religion.

We therefore formally request the United States government to revoke this executive order in its current form and use existing immigration mechanisms to achieve its stated goals.

ARVO will continue to monitor this situation and serve as a resource to all of its members, most importantly those who are directly affected by this order.
